Minutes of the Technical Bids Evaluation Committee Meeting Held on 25.03.2026 In the Chamber of Superintending Engineer, National Highways Circle, Bangalore

Name of the Work: "Maintenance estimate from Km 658.824 to 666.124 and Rain damaged portion at Ch.659.176 Km of NH-150A, Jevargi-Chamarajanagara Section approved under M&R State for the year 2025-26"

Preamble

The Secretary to Government of Karnataka, Public Works Department, Vikasa Soudha, Bangalore vide letter No. 122 dated :16.02.2026 has accorded financial allocation of Rs. 100.00 Lakhs for the maintenance work of NH-275. Accordingly, the Executive Engineer, National Highways Division, Bangalore has prepared an estimate based on the National Highway Schedule of Rates 2022-23 continued for the year 2025-26 amounting to Rs. 75.00 Lakhs for the work of "Maintenance estimate from Km 658.824 to 666.124 and Rain damaged portion at Ch.659.176 Km of NH-150A, Jevargi-Chamarajanagara Section approved under M&R State for the year 2025-26".

Administrative approval and Technical Sanction is accorded by central office assigning the sanction No. CER No. 21/2025-26, dated 04.03.2026 for an amount of Rs. 75.00 Lakhs.

Tender was called for the said work vide Notification No. 14/2025-26 dated 10.03.2026 through e-portal <https://eprocure.gov.in> by the Executive Engineer, NH Division, Bangalore. Amount put to tender is Rs. 63.54 Lakhs (excluding GST) and the calendar of events were as under:

1. Request of Tender Document From : 11.03.2026 at 11.00 Hrs
2. Request of Tender Document To : 23.03.2026 at 16.00 Hrs
3. Tender closing Date and Time : 23.03.2026 at 16.30 Hrs
4. Technical bid open Date & Time : 24.03.2026 at 16.00 Hrs
5. Time & Date of opening of Financial bid : After approval of Technical Bid

The Technical Bids were opened on 24.03.2026 @16.00 Hrs, in response and 2 bidders have participated in the tender. The following 2 bidders have submitted original EMD & LOC within the stipulated date and time of opening of tender as specified in the Notice Inviting Tender. The bidder's documents were downloaded and considered for evaluation:

2. Sri. Venugopal K B , Mysore.

The technical bid documents substantiating the qualification criteria indicated in the KW-3 were verified and the committee has resolved the qualification criteria of bidders as under:

TECHNICAL EVALUATION

1. Sri. B Swamy Gowda, Mysore

The committee verified the downloaded documents as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bangalore. It has been noticed that bidder has submitted (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a), 3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b) and 4) bankers certificates for credit facilities as per clause 3.3b.

The Confirmation pertaining to Work done has been obtained and is in line with the submitted Bid documents. Hence the documents submitted by the bidder satisfies the conditions as per the Bid Document and is technically Responsive.

2. Sri. Venugopal K B , Mysore.

The committee verified the downloaded documents as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bangalore. It has been noticed that bidder has submitted (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per

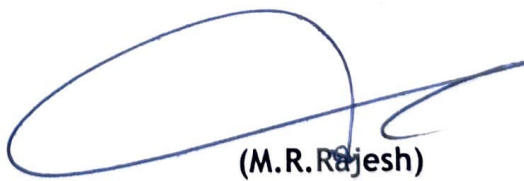
