**MINUTES FOR TECHNICAL BID EVALUATION HELD ON 11.05.2026**

**NAME OF WORK:** - Repair Rehabilitation & Embankment Protection of Bridge Nos. 13/1, 22/1, 25/1, 27/1, 29/1, 31/1, 31/2 and 38/1 on NH-427 under PWD, Guwahati NH Division Guwahati, in the state of Assam, under Annual Plan for the year 2025-26". (Job No. Br./427/AS/2025-26/288).

(A) Reference of according sanction to the project:

- i) Authority : R.O., MoRT&H, Guwahati.
- ii) Sanction letter : NH-12014/194/2025/AS/NE (C.No.257520), Dated 09-02-2026
- iii) Sanctioned amount of Estimate:- Rs.13.53 Cr.

(B) Bidding Process:-

- (i) Bid Value: Rs. 10.8957 Cr.

The IFB for the work was issued by the Chief Engineer, (NH Works), PWD Assam vide letter vide IFB No. NHC/BR/01/2026/04 dated 12/03/2026 with bid due date on 17.04.2026 upto 14:00 hrs. The Bidding documents were made available in the CPPP, MoRT&H of <https://eprocure.gov.in> from 13-03-2026 to 17-04-2026 up to 14.00 hrs.

- (ii) Pre-bid Meeting: The Pre-bid meeting was fixed on 27-03-2026. However, no queries were raised in the Pre-bid meeting.
- (iii) Date stipulated for receiving the bid document: The deadline for submission of online bid was 17.04.2026 up to 14.00 hours.

(vi) Technical Bid opening: -

The online technical bids were opened on 20.04.2026 after 14.00 hrs in the office Chamber of CE (NH), in presence of Bid Evaluation committee members & representatives of bidders. Total 4 (Four) nos. of bids from the following bidders were received through online mode in the portal of CPPP website <https://eprocure.gov.in> from the following bidders:-

1. New Horizon Enterprise, H No 26, MC Road, Piyali Phukan Bazaar, Bamunimaidan, Guwahati, Assam – 781021.
2. MAEC CONHAB Pvt. Ltd, A2 404 Coral Woods Narmadapuram Road, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh-462047.
3. MIDAS Construction, 1B, Royal Silver Tower, Lachit Nagar Main Road, Next to Bye Lane-1, Ulubari, Guwahati-781007, Assam.
4. Kushal Konwar, Milan Nagar, P.O: C.R. Building, Dibrugarh-786003, Assam.

In view of above, BEC has decided to go for evaluation of the bids of the above mentioned bidders who have submitted/uploaded the online bid documents on CPPP website.



(C) Evaluation of Technical Bids: -

Confirmation of BGs and Demand Drafts submitted as bid securities by the bidders were obtained from the respective Banks.

To establish the responsiveness of each & every individual's technical bids, the qualification information submitted online by the bidders have been examined on the basis of technical qualification criteria laid down in the bidding documents and compiled in the form of a statement – "TABLE FOR EVALUATION OF SUBSTANTIVE RESPONSIVENESS OF TECHNICAL BIDS" to be placed before the Bid Evaluation Committee.

(D) The meeting of Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC) for technical evaluation of bids is held on 30.04.2026 at the office chamber of the CE (NH), in presence of CE (NH) as Chairman of Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC).

(E) The Bid Evaluation Committee verified and examined the documents of the technical bids & all other relevant papers. The deliberations of the Bid evaluation committee are as follows:-

1. **New Horizon Enterprise**, H No 26, MC Road, Piyali Phukan Bazaar, Bamunimaidan, Guwahati, Assam – 781021: - Available Threshold Technical Capacity of the bidder is less than the total required Threshold Technical Capacity. Hence, Bidder is liable to be disqualified as per Clause 2.2.2.2.(i) of the RFP.
2. **MAEC CONHAB Pvt. Ltd**, A2 404 Coral Woods Narmadapuram Road, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh-462047: -

(i) The bidder has not submitted certificate from Statutory Auditor or Cost Auditor of the company (in case of companies) or from a practicing Cost Accountant or practicing Chartered Accountant (in respect of suppliers other than companies) giving the percentage. In this regard, representative of RO, made his observations "as per Ministry's letter no. RW/NH-33044/88/2021- S&R (P&B)/ DNT (215840) dated 18.01.2023, if the certificate for local content has not been submitted by the bidder in its Technical Bid, an opportunity must be given to the bidder to submit the desired certificate during technical evaluation of Bid."

The Chairman, BEC, along with other members, concurred with the above observation and decided not to disqualify the bidder on this ground.

(ii) The CA certificate in support of Annexure IV of Appendix IA is not found as per requirement while verifying the UDIN of the certificate in UDIN portal. In UDIN portal no details of financial year wise payment received is found which is required for calculating the Threshold Technical Capacity. In this regard representative of RO, made his observations "The bidder has submitted the required documents as per Annexure-IV duly certified by CA regarding the payments received. The Threshold Technical capacity of the bidder is Rs. 15.06 Cr. which is more than - the minimum threshold technical capacity i.e. Rs. 8.17 Cr as per Clause 2.2.2.2 (i) of the RFP. The UDIN certificate shows the details of the project and the certificate is valid." Further it was stated that "the UDIN serves only to establish the authenticity of the certificate issued by the chartered Accountant. In

respect of the bidder MAEC CONHAB PRV LTD it was pointed out that although year-wise figures are not reflected in the UDIN record available on the ICAI UDIN portal, the overall project cost/ financial figures are consistent with the certificate submitted. It was clarified that absence of a detailed year-wise break-up in the UDIN does not constitute a valid ground for disqualification, particularly when the UDIN has been verified on the portal and found to be active. It was further stated that any requirement of additional details should be addressed by seeking clarification from the bidder and that disqualification on this ground, despite the presence of a valid and active UDIN, would be unwarranted.”

However, the Chairman, BEC, along with other members, opined that the CA certificate in respect of Annexure IV specifically pertains to financial year-wise payments received from construction projects, which is a critical parameter for determining the Threshold Technical Capacity. As per the council of Institute of Chartered Accountants of India’s decision taken at its 379th Meeting held on 17th & 18th December, 2018, UDIN has been made mandatory in phased manner and for all Certificates w.e.f. 1st February, 2019. As mentioned in FAQ on UDIN published by UDIN Directorate, The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India “UDIN will secure the certificates/reports/ document attested/certified by practicing CAs. This will also enable the Regulators/Banks/Third parties to check the authenticity of the certificates/reports/documents.” As per this, UDIN verification must reflect the data entered on the CA certificate. Upon verification of the UDIN, while some details such as project cost, date of commencement, and date of completion are available, no information regarding financial year-wise payments received is reflected. In view of this, the authenticity of the financial year-wise payments received could not be established, and consequently, the Threshold Technical Capacity could not be ascertained with certainty. Accordingly, the Chairman, BEC decided not to consider the submitted CA certificate as valid for the purpose of evaluation under this criterion.

In view of the above fact, bidder is liable to be disqualified as per Clause 2.2.2.2(i) and Clause 2.2.2.7 of the RFP.

3. **MIDAS Construction**, 1B, Royal Silver Tower, Lachit Nagar Main Road, Next to Bye Lane-1, Ulubari, Guwahati-781007, Assam: - Qualification information submitted by the bidder is found to be **in order** as per stipulations of RFP.
4. **Kushal Konwar**, Milan Nagar, P.O: C.R. Building, Dibrugarh-786003, Assam: -  
(i) Annexure III of Appendix IA is incomplete. (ii) Net worth certificate submitted is not till FY 2024-25 and Methodology adopted for calculation of Net Worth is not submitted. (iii) Balance sheet auditor's certificate, profit & loss for FY 2024-25 not furnished. Hence, Bidder is liable to be disqualified as per Clause 2.2.2.3, Clause 2.2.2.8 and Clause 2.2.2.9(ii) of the RFP.

In view of above, the Bid Evaluation Committee had finalized the names of the technically responsive & non-responsive bidders and are depicted in the Table for Evaluation of Substantive Responsiveness of Technical Bids & also stated below

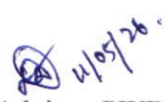

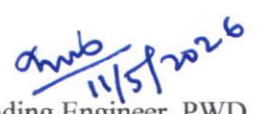
- i. The Procurement was satisfactorily advertised in central public procurement portal of MoRT&H website <https://eprocure.gov.in> and sufficient time of 35 days i.e. from 12.03.2026 to 17.04.2026 has been given for submission of bids.
- ii. The qualification criteria were not unduly restrictive.
- iii. The third criteria regarding "prices are reasonable as compared to market values" cannot be assessed at this moment as the financial bid has not opened yet.

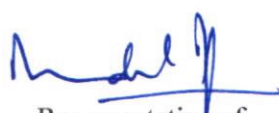
In view of This the BEC recommended for opening of the financial bid of the technically responsive bidder to assess the third criteria.
