

Minutes of Meeting of Evaluation Committee for Re-evaluation of Technical Bid for Short term maintenance Contracts (STMC) of NH 122 A (Vishwanathpur chowk Ch. km 0.000 to Kharka basant Ch. km31.820) on existing alignment under NH Division Sitamarhi for the year 2025-26 in the state of Bihar held on 15-06-2026 in the office of Chief Engineer, NH (North) Wing, RCD, Bihar, Patna.

Amount put to Tender: - Rs. 4.5455Cr.

1. The above-mentioned work was sanctioned by MoRT&H, Government of India vide file no.- RW/PAT/NH-122A/Km 0.00 to Km 31.820/STMC/2025-26-1646 Computer no-259349 dated 06-10-2025 (Job no-STMC/NH-122A/25-26-04) amounting to Rs. 4.6593305 Cr. The amount of the work put to tender was Rs. 4.5455Cr.
2. 1st time bid for the above-mentioned work was invited online by Executive Engineer, NH Division, Sitamarhi vide NIT dated-06-10-2025 on e-procurement site with Bid Due date -04-11-2025. Technical bid was opened on 05-11-2025 in which single bidder Ram kumar singh was participated, the bid was cancelled by the Engineer-in-chief (work) RCD Bihar vide letter no-1794(E) dated-11-03-2026 due to insufficient time for tendering process.
3. 2nd time bid invited by Executive Engineer, NH Division, Sitamarhi vide NIT dated-09-04-2026 on e-procurement site with Bid Due date-25-05-2026. Technical bid was opened on 26-05-2026 in which following three bidders participated.

4. The technical bid of the above bidders was evaluated by the Evaluation Committee on 15-06-2026 and the details Average annual turnover for last three years, Amount of similar nature work & Bid Capacity as tabulated below:-

5. The Evaluation Committee found that 2 bidders out of 3 are Technically Non-Responsive, their reason as following: -

1	Abhiraj Kumar	Non-Responsive (i) Bidder doesn't achieve minimum average annual financial turnover as per clause 4.3 A(a) of RFP. (ii) Bidder doesn't submitted undertaking that the bidder is not affiliated to the firm or entity that has been hired or employed by the Employer for preparation of bid documents or to supervise the contract as per Clause 4.1(h) of RFP
2	M/S. KABBU KHIRHAR	Non-Responsive (i) Bidder doesn't submitted undertaking that the bidder is not affiliated to the firm or entity that has been hired or employed by the Employer for preparation of bid documents or to supervise the contract as per Clause 4.1(h) of RFP

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6. Both technically non-responsive bidders, have submitted their representation. The evaluation committee has examined their representation and following decision:

Reason for Non responsive	Evaluation Committee Decision
<u>Abhiraj Kumar</u> I. Bidder doesn't achieve minimum average annual financial turnover as per clause 4.3 A (a) of RFP. II. Bidder doesn't submitted undertaking that the bidder is not affiliated to the firm or entity that has been hired or employed by the Employer for preparation of bid documents or to supervise the contract as per Clause 4.1(h) of RFP	I) Bidder Abhiraj Kumar has achieved average annual financial turnover i.e. Rs-7.4551 Cr. as per clause 4.3 A (a) of RFP. II) Both bidders have admitted in its representation that it failed to upload the mandatory undertaking required under Clause 4.1(h) of the RFP. The said clause specifically requires submission of an "Undertaking that the bidder is not affiliated to the firm or entity that has been hired or employed by the Employer for preparation of bid documents or to supervise the contract." Further, Clause 4.3 B(a)(b) of the RFP expressly stipulates that failure to submit the certificates/documents as specified shall make the bid non-responsive. Since the bidder admittedly failed to submit the mandatory undertaking along with its bid, the bid suffers from a material non-compliance with the requirements of the RFP and is therefore liable to be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
<u>M/S. KABBU KHIRHAR</u> I. Bidder doesn't submitted undertaking that the bidder is not affiliated to the firm or entity that has been hired or employed by the Employer for preparation of bid documents or to supervise the contract as per Clause 4.1(h) of RFP	The omission cannot be treated as a minor procedural deficiency, as the undertaking forms part of the mandatory bid documents prescribed under the RFP. Permitting its submission after bid opening would amount to allowing the bidder to rectify a material defect in its bid, contrary to the terms of the RFP and the principles of fair and transparent tendering.

7. The Evaluation Committee during scrutiny of representation of **Abhiraj Kumar**; observes that **OM SAI CONSTRUCTION** has suppressed the information regarding "Construction of Panchayat sarkar Bhawan at Jalalpur Gangati Panchayat Block Mahua District-Vaishali." It is made misleading or

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false representations in bidding process as per RFP clause 4.5(i). It also reinforced by OM SAI CONSTRUCTION by his letter no-OSC/CE/NH(N) W/PATNA/2026-27/122 dated-19-06-2026.

8. The Evaluation Committee after examination the representation from the bidders, results as tabulated below: -

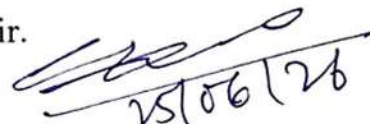
