2. At the outset, the Chief Engineer (NH, R&B), PWD welcomed the participants, the Executive Engineer-WD-XIV(NH), appraised the Technical Evaluation Committee that in its first meeting held on 26/06/2026 had scrutinized the technical bids received against Tender No. 03/2026-27 Dt: 23/04/2026. During the detailed examination of the bids, the Committee observed that four (04) bidders were found technically non-responsive due to the non-compliance with the requirements stipulated in the tender document whereas, Five (05) bidders were responsive.
3. All the non-responsive bidders have submitted their clarifications and supporting documents. The Committee verified the clarification and assessed the same with reference to the provisions of the tender document. Based on the evaluation, the committee arrived at the following decision.

1	Rajaram Construction	The bidder has submitted clarification towards similar works completed as per the criteria.	Based on the representation submitted by the bidder, the committee deliberated that the bidder has executed CRF work on EPC Mode as per MoRTH guidelines. CRF work is to be executed as per NH specifications. Further CRF works are considered as eligible project as per model EPC RFP. Accordingly, the committee considered the CRF work for qualification and the bidder responsive.
2	Arcons Infrastructures and Constructions Pvt. Ltd.	The bidder has submitted clarification towards similar works completed as per the criteria.	Based on the representation submitted, the committee deliberated that, execution of Highway work is mentioned in the completion certificate. Further the scope of the submitted work includes all highway related items. Hence the bidder is considered responsive.
3	Harsh Constructions Private Limited	The bidder has submitted the representation regarding inadvertent clerical error while mentioning the months required to complete ongoing works.	As per the representation submitted, the committee deliberated that the bid capacity is qualifying the minimum requirement and hence the bidder is considered responsive.
4	M/s Rane Constructions	The bidder has submitted Client Certificate for similar completed work which was uploaded on CPPP Portal.	As per the representation submitted, the committee noted that the bidder has submitted the Client Certificate towards the work executed as sub-contractor. Hence the bidder is considered responsive.

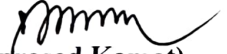
