1. The Superintending Engineer, National Highway (North) Circle, Kozhikode invites bids on online mode for the work detailed in the table. The bidders may submit bids for the following work:

2. Bidding documents and other details may be downloaded from the e-procurement portal of MoRTH , <https://eprocure.gov.in>. Registered A class bidder who have successfully completed at least ***one similar work costing more than 40% (Forty percentage) of the estimate PAC of the work during the last five years*** and who posses Class III Compatible Digital Signature Certificate issued by competent authority can only participate in the tender. The instructions contained in sub section B, C and D of Section I of the Bid document regarding bidding documents, preparation of bids and submission of bids stands modified in lines with the online bidding procedure indicated in Section I of the bidding documents. Bill of quantities/Schedule of works can be downloaded only by remitting a tender processing fee indicated in the website by Govt.of India. All eligible/interested contractors are directed to get enrolled online and obtain Digital signature certificate in-order to download the tender documents and participate in the subsequent bidding process.

3. The non-refundable tender fee must be credited to Central Government through **Bharatkosh portal (<https://bharatkosh.gov.in>)** and also must be accompanied by scanned copy of bank guarantee towards bids security (EMD), ***drawn in favour of superintending Engineer, National Highway North Circle, Kozhikode.*** Bank guarantee issued as surety for the bid shall be valid for 45 days beyond the Bid validity date i.e. minimum 165 days.
4. Price bid shall be submitted in Cover II of online bidding.
5. Bids must be submitted ***online on or before 25.07.2026, 05.00 PM.*** Bids received on “ online” shall be ***opened at 11.00 A.M, 28 .07.2026*** by Technical Evaluation Committee and the list of ***technically qualified bidders will be uploaded within 15 days from the date of bid opening.*** The ***financial bid will be opened by the committee*** headed by ***superintending Engineer, National Highway***

**North Circle, Kozhikode** in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend. The date of financial Bid opening will be intimated online at the time of uploading result of Technical Evaluation. If the office he office happens to be closed for any reason, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.

**6. The hard copy of *bid documents containing the followings shall be submitted on or before 05.00PM on 27.07.2026***

- i. Registration Certificate attested by a Gazetted Officer
- ii. Experience Certificate prescribed in Bidding Document attested by a Gazetted Officer
- iii. Scanned copy of remittance towards Bid Security , Tender fee ,GST reverse charge invoice
- iv. Bank guarantee for Bid security
- v. Preliminary Agreement in stamp paper worth Rs.200/- signed by the Contractor
- vi. The bidder shall own /produce proof of ownership of Hot Mix batch type Asphalt plant 100-120 capacity
- vii. All relevant documents mentioned in the bidding document for prequalification evaluation

**7. The Hard copy of the bid containing documents mentioned in clause 6 above shall be submitted at the following office:-**

**8. All details including experience required for the bidders can be seen in the bidding documents including standard bidding documents and subsequent amendments.**

**9. Subsequent Corrigendum/Addendum if required shall only be available in web site indicated above.**

**10. The bidding authority reserves the right to cancel any or all bid without assigning any reasons. The PWD will not be responsible for any error, line missing of Schedule data while downloading by the bidder.**

**11. The contractor should furnish the copies of invoices of purchase of bitumen along with the running/final bills for payment.**

**12. Quality control for the various items in this project shall be governed by the provisions of PWD Quality Control (QC) Manual approved vide G.O.(Rt) No.1339/2015/PWD dated, 10.9.2015 and the PWD Laboratory Manual approved vide G.O.(Rt) No. 1346/2015/PWD dated, 11.9.2015 and published in the PWD Web portal.**

**13. The intending bidders are expected to familiarize with the contents of the QC Manual so published before participating in the bid.**

**14. Technical Audit as envisaged in clause 2406 shall be carried out for the project. The agency entrusted shall extend full co-operation for carrying out the Technical Audit.**

**15. The bidder whose tender is finally approved is bound to post technical personnel who are well versed with the quality control tests and other guidelines stipulated in the QC Manual.**

**16. For projects costing more than Rs.200 Lakhs, the entrusted agency shall establish site laboratories with required facilities.**

17. Primary responsibility for ensuring quality control in each item of work in the project shall be vested with the agency entrusted with the project.
18. The entrusted agency shall conduct first tier quality control tests for all items of work at the site laboratory/approved laboratory as per procedure stipulated in the Manuals at his own expense.
19. The agency shall rectify all defects identified during the first and second tier QC tests and during the Technical Audit (third tier)
20. Where ever specified, the entrusted agency shall also obtain Manufacturer's Test Certificate from the manufacturer/dealer and submit the same before executing the items listed in such certificates.
21. The rates quoted by the bidders shall include all expenses for carrying out the first tier quality control tests. Expenses for third party tests detailed in clause 7.4 of the Introduction in the QC Manual, if required, shall also be borne by the agency entrusted with the project.
22. If any changes/amendments occur in the conditions of these types of tenders as contemplated in the rules in force those changes would be applicable for this tender also.
