General Conditions for Eligible Tenderers

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1	Bidders should be Eligible Class, Civil contractor registered in KPWD/MORT&H.
2	Bidders shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any State Government / Government of India /Union Territory.
3	It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure credit of Tender Processing Fee, before the last date and time of bid submission. Tender Processing Fee(as per NIT) should be paid in the form of Demand Draft in favour of Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Vijayapur, and original paid receipt scanned copy should be uploaded along with tender documents online through https://eprocure.gov.in portal.
4	The bidder is required to ensure browser compatibility of the computer well in advance to the last date and time for receipt of tenders. The departments shall not be responsible for non-accessibility of e-tendering portal due to internet connectivity issues and technical glitches at bidder's end.
5	Conditional Tenders will not be accepted.
6	The Competent Authority reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons.
7	Each tenderer shall produce experience certificate obtained from not below the rank of Executive Engineer, in successfully completing or substantially completing at least one similar contract of Highway/Road of at least 50% of the value of proposed contract within the last five years. as per sec 3.2(b) of bid document.
8	Only relevant certificates and details shall be furnished. Details of company / agencies / firm profile are to be scan and uploaded.
9	The Field Lab shall preferably be located adjacent to the site office of the Engineers provided, failing which 1% of the amount of work done will be penalized.
10	Bankers Certificate as per the prescribed proforma in the Bid Documents.
11	The Item rates quoted shall include cost of Royalty charges on construction material and other taxes as per the rates provided in prevailing Govt Orders at the time of execution and including

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	cost and conveyance of materials, curing, loading and unloading with all lifts, labours, hire charges of machineries and equipments etc., complete and all other incidental charges. All items shall be executed as directed by the Engineer in charge of the work.
12	The Tenderers are requested to abide instructions and conditions contained in the State Tender Documents and further orders thereon. The information should be submitted in the prescribed formats only.
13	Original scanned copy of the Bid security (EMD) as per NIT/Tender Document should be uploaded along with tender documents online through https://eprocure.gov.in portal and the original should be submitted to the Office of the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Vijayapura. On the date and time of opening the bid. Otherwise, the bids will be rejected.
14	All materials required for this work shall be produced by the tenderer himself and should be got tested by the quality control authorities, at his own cost before using for the work.
15	The Royalty, labour welfare fund and other deductions will be deducted as per prevailing Government Orders.
16	All the items of work included in the scope of work will be executed as per Ministry's Specifications for Road and Bridge Works and Circulars / Guidelines issued by the Ministry from time to time.
17	The documents such as, invoices, sale deed, Work Done Certificate, Turnover, profit loss Account and any other document uploaded should be legible /readable, otherwise such documents will not be considered for evaluation of the Tender.
18	As per the Government Circular No.PWD:15: ITC:2008:2099, Dated:2nd December-2010, the tendered Contractors, should submit the Original Bank Guarantee in the prescribed format only issued by the Bankers for the said work at the time of opening of Technical Bids. The Contractors failing to submit the Original Bank Guarantee will be disqualified and also such contractors will be Black Listed and Debarred from participating in future tenders.
19	It is obligatory for the contractor to use the machineries for various activities involved in the project as per the MoRTH specification and manuals.
20	The supporting documents to be furnished with bids shall be submitted in neatly binded form with each pages numbered.
21	Any other details regarding the work can be obtained from the above office during office hours. The contractor has to thoroughly study the tender documents and to fill up the proforma as per requirement.
22	The bidders should produce original documents for verification at the time of opening of the Technical Bids and attend to any clarification requested by the department, otherwise bids are liable for rejection.
23	In case of the death of a contractor after executing the agreement/commencement of the work, his legal heir, if an eligible registered contractor & willing, can execute & complete the work at the accepted tender rates irrespective of the cost of the work.
24	Joint Venture not applicable.
25	Collection of material on the road side should be so planned that it should commensurate with the physical progress of work and the collected material should not cause any hindrance to the

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	traffic. It must be ensured that the contractor arranges for separate land for storage of road construction material and machinery and these shall not be allowed to be stacked on road side.
26	Bitumen used for the work shall be heated in boilers only and not in drums on open fire. Spraying of bitumen wherever necessary should be done only with the mechanical sprayers and premixing of bitumen and stone aggregates should be done only in the proper mechanical mixer / hot mix plant / batch mix plant.
27	During the course of execution, the traffic may be regulated in accordance with guidelines laid down vide Ministry's letter No. NHIII-33 (126)/72 dated 20-03-1973. Smooth flow of the traffic may be ensured by providing adequate traffic control devices in accordance with stipulation of IRC: SP: 55: 2001.
28	Stipulations made in the Manual for Construction and Supervision of Bituminous works shall be strictly followed during execution of the work.
29	Photo / video record of the work before / during & after construction shall be made available in digital form by the agency. Should submit the copies.
