5. The tenders for the work shall be invited through e-tendering and guidelines issued by this Ministry. The bids for EPC works shall be invited as per standard RFP/agreement of EPC works issued vide Ministry's letter No.RW/NH-37010/4/2010-EAP(Printing)vol-iv dated 05.03.2019.

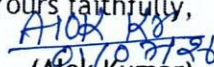
6 . The expenditure is debitable to Major Head '5054' Capital Outlay on Roads & Bridges, 01-National Highways, 01.337 Road Works (Minor Head), 01 Works under Road Wing, 01.02 Other Schemes, 01.02.73 Infrastructural Assets for which the corresponding Demand for the current financial year 2026-27 is '86' Ministry of Road Transport & Highways.

7. The works have been considered on PBMC Mode. There shall not be any separate Authority Engineer for the work to be executed on PBMC Mode and the work shall be supervised by concerned State PWD. Accordingly, Agency charge @ 3% has been allowed. Quarterly progress report of the work shall be submitted on regular basis to the office of CE-RO, MoRTH, Patna.

8. State RCD shall ensure use of plastic waste as per availability as per IRC SP:98-2013 "Guidelines for the use of waste plastic in Hot Bituminous Mix (Dry process) in wearing course".

9. Phasing of expenditure shall be as governed as per Technical Note enclosed for the specified individual work.

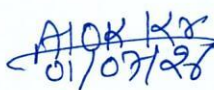
