The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways through National Highways Authority of India is engaged in the development of National Highways and as part of this endeavour, it has been decided to undertake Balance work for Construction of Western Side Spur of Rampur – Rudrapur section connecting NH24 to NH 87 bypassing Rampur Town at Risk and Cost of Contractor on EPC Mode in the state of Uttar Pradesh through an Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contract.

and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any and other documents specified in clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque are submitted physically latest within 5 working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the National Highways Authority of India reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
